The Northeastern Association of the Blind at Albany (NABA) is one of the oldest not-for-profit organizations in the Capital Region founded in 1908. It provides vision rehabilitation, job placement, low vision exams, and adaptive technology training to blind and visually impaired individuals. The organization also provides educational and recreational programming for blind children and programming for blind teens preparing to join the workforce. Our KidSight vision screenings program reaches thousands of preschool children each year.

The New York State Commission for the Blind contracts with NABA to offer a full range of rehabilitation services throughout our 14-county service area and limited services in the other 8 counties. NABA serves individuals ranging from ages 18 months to over 100 years old.
