## 2019 Program Highlights

- The Judith Fund\*, Michael & Margaret Picotte Donor Advised Fund\*, William Gundry Broughton Charitable Private Foundation, Inc. and an anonymous donor provided the financial support allowing the LifePath Living Center @ 80 Central to open in February
- Our agency name changed to LifePath
- LifePath Administrative Offices moved to 28 Colvin Ave. in the City of Albany
- In partnership with Price Chopper/Market 32 we are running a grocery store shuttle
- Financial Literacy classes were held at LifePath Living Center @ Cohoes, thanks to a grant from TD Bank
- W.R. Berkley Corporation Charitable Foundation supported our Diabetes Prevention Program at LifePath Living Center @ Livingston
- B'nai B'rith Gideon Foundation provided a grant which will be instrumental in starting our Shared Housing Program
- Our Living Centers hosted 12 sessions focusing on the history of the region thanks to a grant from The Bender Family Foundation

- 28th Annual Capital Region Senior Expo \$51,735



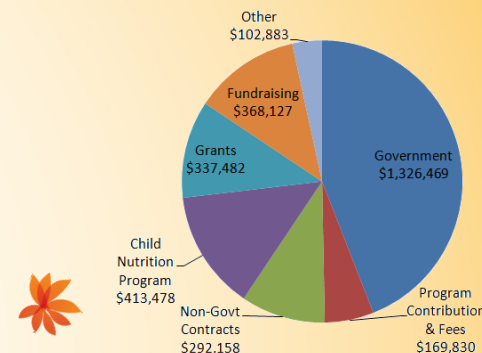
## 2019 Program Outcomes

- 556 older adults enjoyed one or more of our 23,553 community meals
- 1,379 older adults received one-on-one Health Insurance Information Counseling
- Our skilled case managers provided 175 clients with 1,940 hours of one-on-one case assistance
- 307,731 meals prepared and delivered from our Meals on Wheels kitchen
- 21 dedicated staff and 200+ volunteers helped prepare and deliver meals throughout the year
- Our professional staff presented at numerous conferences and seminars, and conducted 104 educational programs, attended by 1,489 individuals
- Our professional drivers provided 8,644 rides
- More than 35 caregivers benefited from our telephone support groups, one-on-one counseling sessions, and educational programs
- 34 seniors received more than 16,095 hours of care while spending their days with friends in a safe environment at our Social Adult Day Programs



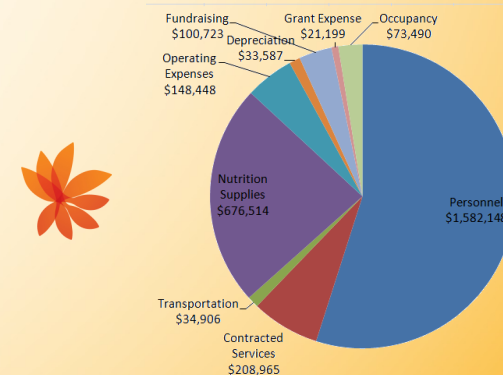
## 2019 Financial Statement

### Revenue



LifePath revenue comes from many different sources. Government funds from NYS Office for Aging, Albany County, the City of Albany, and the City of Watervliet continue to be the largest source of revenue.

### Expenses



LifePath strives to maintain the lowest possible overhead costs in order to ensure the majority of our expenses are utilized for programs and supports to help our older neighbors and friends stay healthy, safe, and connected to our communities.

LifePath's Total Assets were \$672,935 and Total Liabilities \$533,954.
